

The float will carry living examples of Gospel proclaimers in the appearances of former Speaker Dr. Dale Meyer, Speaker Emeritus Dr. Ken Klaus, and Rev. Dr. Gregory Seltz, current Speaker of The Lutheran Hour.

The float will salute the 100th anniversary of the International Lutheran Laymen's League, which led the way in launching The Lutheran Hour in 1930. Additionally, the float will recognize LWML's 75th Anniversary.
