Bylaws



The LWML Structure Committee presented the proposed changes. Changes were driven by National By-Law changes.

- Young Women Rep/Heart to Heart Sisters duties were adjusted.
- The word *Woman* changed to *Women* everywhere appropriate.
- Removal of MMV Program – both National and District ended.
- Department Names reflect National Changes: Human Care to Special Focus Ministries; and, Servant Resources to Organizational Resources
- Organizational Resources Dept shall include Leaders of Development Committee and Structure Committee
- Special Focus Ministries Dept shall include Human Care Committee and Young Women Committee and Heart to Heart Sisters Committee
