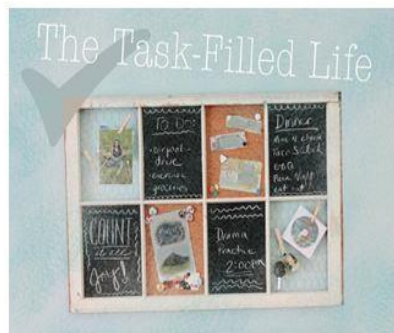
### **Gospel Outreach**
